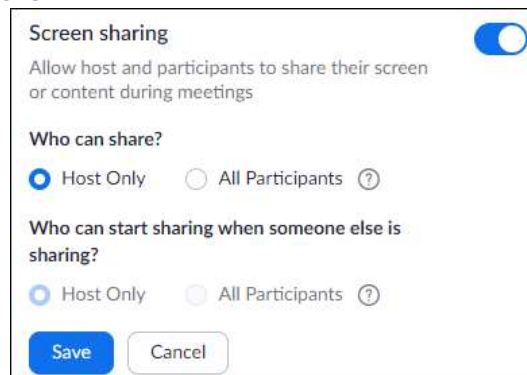


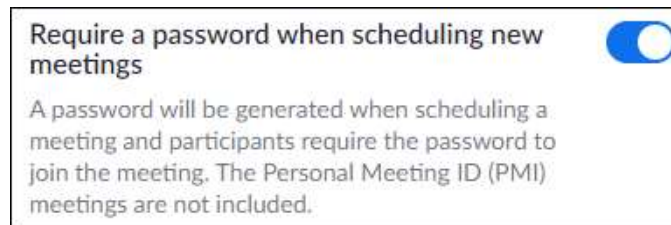
There's been a rise of ZOOM accounts being created and used since the mandatory Work From Home Initiative has been enforced. In recent reports, there have been some concerns about individuals being able to join meetings without invitations. FS-ISAC would like to ensure everyone is using the Zoom platform as securely as possible.

## Best Practices

For individuals hosting large meetings with a public audience, please configure your settings to only allow the host and co-host/Panelist to share their screens. The setting can be found in your Zoom Profile which you can access via OKTA.



For individuals hosting private meetings, please considering setting password protection by default. This helps prevent uninvited users from joining. The setting can be found in your Zoom Profile which you can access via OKTA.



If you have a Zoom meeting scheduled, please open the meeting in Outlook and click **“Change Settings”** and click the checkbox for **“Required Password”**. A password will be generated automatically or you can create one. Once saved the password will be included in the invitation.
